

Grismore steers four winners at Scioto

Columbus, OH --- Top reinman Greg Grismore has certainly made his presence known in the opening week of the Scioto Downs meet as he bagged four more winners on Saturday night. The 40-year-old Ohio native is splitting his driving duties between The Meadows and Scioto.

Also on Saturday, Mcmantle, a son of Mcardle, made his sophomore debut in impressive style for trainer-driver Jim Daily by getting up to defeat a group of older horses in 1:55.4.

Daily kept him in second place while Grismore and Camcoder cut moderate fractions, but in the stretch Mcmantle rallied to overtake the leader and Spartan Pride to win by a neck. He paid \$6.40 to win.

Last year Mcmantle took a mark of 1:54.3 winning a Pennsylvania Sires Stakes at Pocono. He is owned by the Down The Lane Stables of Franklin, Ohio.

Dailey got another win on Saturday night when Avenue A took the opening leg of the Columbus Claiming Series. The 7-year-old son of Artsplace swung three wide in the final turn to roar past the leaders and win by 2-3/4 lengths in 1:56. He defeated Chisum and Stubbysleisure Guy.

Frenchy Fuller trains Avenue A for Ida Hartman of Delaware, Ohio. It was his second win in six starts in 2010.
